Beginning this summer, I will be introducing an in-house dental plan specifically crafted for patients with no dental insurance or those with a flex spending account. By paying one yearly fee, the NFD Benefits Plan will cover your hygiene visits, radiographs, fluoride treatments, doctor's exams, oral cancer screening, intraoral pictures, and apply either a 15 or 18% discount to all restorative treatment (fillings, crowns, root canals, bridges, etc.). There is no yearly maximum and no waiting period. Stop allowing insurance companies to dictate your oral health!

DENTAMAX insurance holders:

Beginning January 1, 2020, Dr. Talcott will no longer individually participate with Dentamax insurance policies. This does not mean you need to switch dentists. If you carry a Dentamax plan (Blue Cross/Blue Shield, Humana, etc.), see any of our hygienists, Dr. Anderson, and you may continue to see Dr. Talcott as well, however, your co-pay **MAY INCREASE**. **Patients are responsible for all co-pays at the time of service.** Make the switch to the NFD Benefits Plan and avoid the hassle of dealing with insurance companies.
